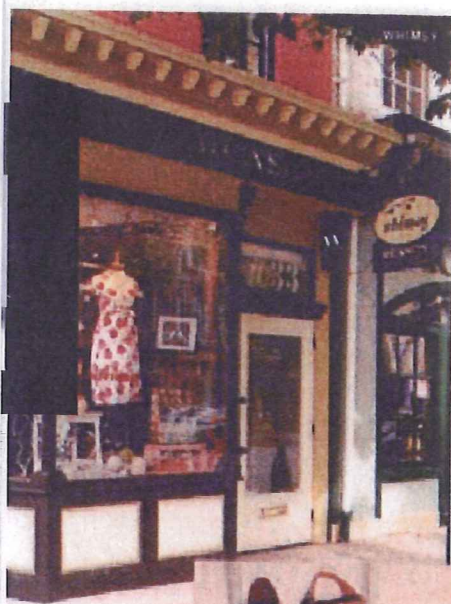


The burgeoning **Baltimore** shopping scene bulks up with three great new arrivals.
